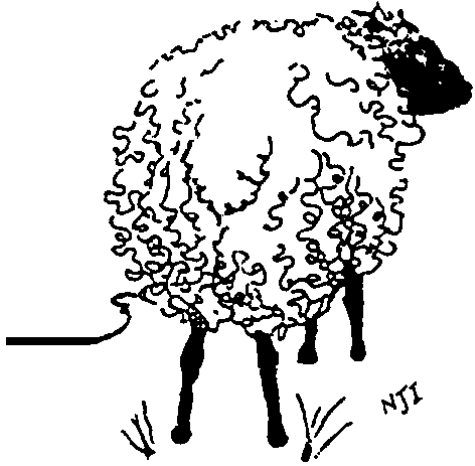

Eligibility

Open to all individual members of ASH. Those who are not currently members of ASH may participate in the exhibition by paying membership dues.

Entry Fees

There is a fee of \$3 for each entry.

Selection

Our intention is to encourage all members to participate. However, the committee does reserve the right to refuse items.

Submission and Deadline

Entries must be received by June 15, 2021. Refer to submission details. They can be dropped off at the June potluck or you can contact the committee chair, Fran Nowakowski, to make other arrangements.

The entry form will be available online at the end of May. Fee payment and delivery details will follow after the form is submitted.

Awards

Ribbons will be presented in each category for first, second and third. As well, the Mary Black Award for Excellence in Weaving and the Joan Thorne Award for Excellence in Spinning will be awarded by the judges. There will also be a People's Choice award determined by visitors votes.

Categories

- A) Household item - woven
- B) Blanket / Throw - woven
- C) Rug - woven
- D) Garment - woven
- E) Accessory - woven
- F) Scarf - woven
- G) Tapestry / hanging - woven
- H) Woven article using recycled material
- I) Woven interlacement - not constructed on a shaft loom. i.e. kumihimo, inkle, card, bead or frame looms
- J) Article using your own handspun yarn, any technique.
- K) Skein of handspun 100% wool yarn
- L) Skein of handspun yarn using wool blend or other fibre
- M) Skein of handspun yarn using special or novelty techniques.

Submission Details

- Items must have been created since August 2018.
- You can only submit **one item** in each category.
- Please attach a label to each item with your name and the category
- Items must be ready to install.
- For categories K, L & M: Provide a skein at least twenty-five (25) yards long secured adequately for handling and labelled with -
 1. Your name
 2. Fibre content
 3. Method of preparation - spinning technique, equipment used, etc.
 4. Finishing (washing, steam, etc.)
 5. Suggested use
